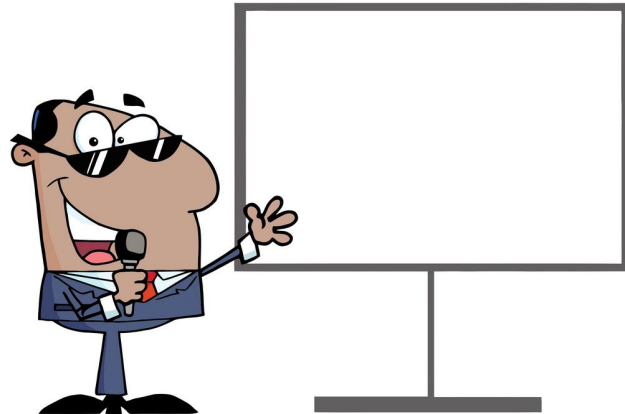
Handwriting challenge: Complete a line of the letter 'h,H' both lowercase and Capital. Then think of two words with this letter at the start.

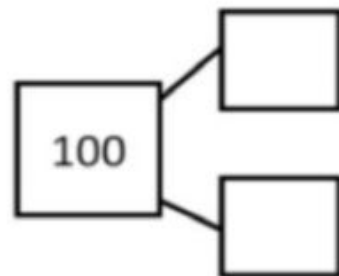
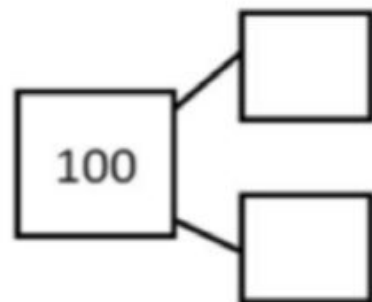
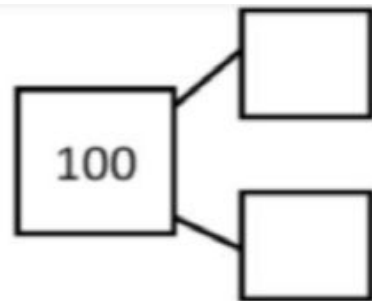
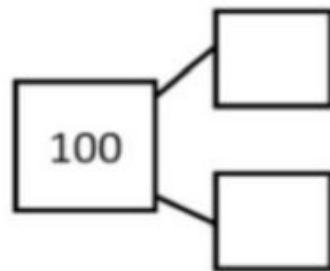
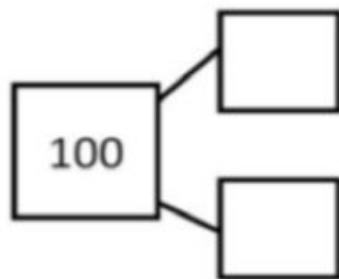
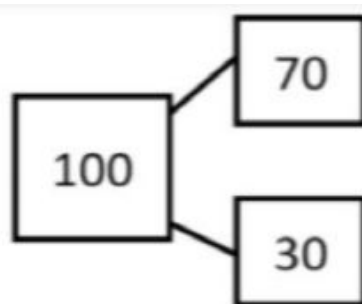
Hint:

Ten straws to represent Dienes ten sticks.

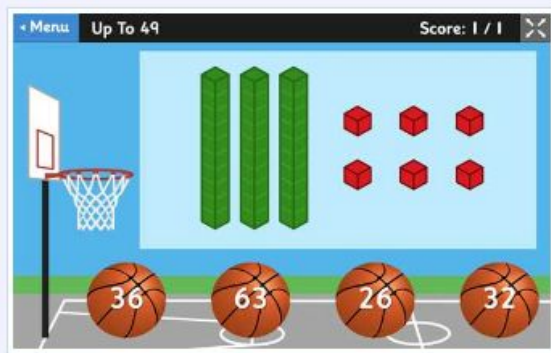
