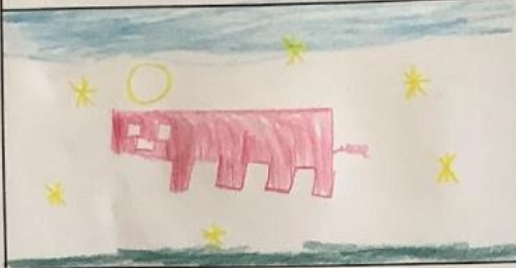


HOVERING HOGS HIT VILLAGE
