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

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**Year 1 Autumn 2 - Curriculum Map**

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English:</b></p> <p><b>Key texts:</b> <b>Six Dinner Sid</b> <b>Farmer Duck</b> <b>A first book of Nature</b></p> <p>Over the course of this half term the children will explore contemporary fiction by writing stories that reflect on their own experiences. A recount of a day out and finally Poetry - in particular vocabulary building.</p> <p><b>Key Vocabulary:</b> Noun, suffix, plural, capital letter, finger space, list, label, caption, rhyming, poems</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Music:</b></p> <p>The children will learn how to sing one song and perform in small groups. The class will begin to understand and use some general musical terms and specific vocabulary linked to the song. The children will explore percussion instruments and focus on the musical element <b>pulse/beat</b>.</p> <p><b>Key Vocabulary:</b> Pulse/beat, Rhythm, Pitch, Hip hop, Music, Perform, Style, Instrumen</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>D&amp;T:</b></p> <p><b>Make a bird feeder</b></p> <p>The class will create their own bird feeder using appropriate techniques. Children begin to evaluate their finished products.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Art:</b> <b>Drawing</b></p> <p>Introduction of art concept (line) - experiment line and explore observational drawing techniques. We will build on previous knowledge by creating artwork combining drawing and colour skills.</p> <p><b>Key Vocabulary:</b> Observe, line, thick, thin, soft, broad, narrow, fine, pattern, detail</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Computing:</b> <b>E-Safety</b></p> <p>Aim to introduce basic E-safety skills. Children will learn about potential dangers and what steps to take to keep safe.</p> <p><b>Key Vocabulary:</b> Ipad, Chromebook, Login, Password, Safe, Personal, information, Private, Programme, Space bar, Save, Stranger, parental permission, Online, Communicate, Drive, Trusted adult, Email, Search, Tell</p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Mathematics:</b></p> <p>The children will be exploring the key mathematical concepts of Place Value, Addition and Subtraction.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science:</b> <b>Key Topic - Plants and Seasonal Change</b></p> <p>The children identify the four seasons by exploring the world around them. They will describe autumn and winter and the</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Geography:</b> <b>Place Knowledge and Field work</b></p> <p>The children will study the human and physical geography of Stibbard. They will understand that Stibbard is a village and it's</p>	<p><b>Key Vocabulary:</b> Past, Poppy, Memory, Remember, Remembrance, 11 Nov 1914-1918, 1939, 1945</p>

<p>To develop greater understanding the children will explore and answer problem solving and reasoning questions.</p> <p><b>Key Vocabulary:</b> addition, subtraction, equal, more, less, greater</p>	<p>associated weather conditions. We will learn what the word weather means and find out how different types of weather can be measured.</p> <p>They will begin to learn about the world of plants alongside beginning to understand and identify deciduous and evergreen trees.</p> <p><b>Key Vocabulary:</b> Season, seasonal, winter, spring, summer, autumn, observe, describe, temperature, rainfall, rain, fog, cool, Tree, deciduous, evergreen, autumn, spring, annual</p>	<p>near Fakenham which is a town.
