

Hook in: video Nobody Stands

Examine what the major religions believe in concerning life after death. Make links and find contrasts between beliefs. Understand that people's beliefs impact on the way they behave.

Science



Explore the theory of evolution and the concept of inheritance. Identify the scientific evidence that has been used to support or refute the theory.

VOCAB: Fossils, Adaptation, Evolution, Characteristics, Reproduction, Genetics, Natural selection, characteristics, evidence, parent, offspring, inherit, inherited, characteristic, environmental, adapt, adaptation, evolve, environment, species, breed newspaper report of the events

VOCAB: archaic language headline, quotes, direct and reported speech, emotive language, orientation, column

resurrection, perpetual, permanent, unceasing, unending, immortal, world view

History

Hook in: poem 'It wasn't me' by Steve Turner

Explore crime & punishment in Roman, Anglo-Saxon and Viking times.

VOCAB: pillory, judge, juty, trial, crucifixion, weregild, tithings, trial by ordeal

French

Recap phonetics and pronunciation. Repeat and recognise the vocabulary for school subjects. Say what subjects they like and dislike at school. Say why they like/ dislike certain school subjects. Tell the time (on the hour) in French. Say what time they study certain subjects at school.

VOCAB: les matieres, j'etudie, French vocab for time & subjects

Geography



Learn about the features of rivers, recap

the water cycle and identify and name bodies of water.

VOCAB: evaporation, precipitation, condensation, cloud formation, rivers, lakes, oceans, seas, reservoirs, bays, straits, gulfs, glaciers and fjords.

PSHE/RSE

Explore feelings, relating well to others and having a growth mindset

VOCAB: grit, resilient, overcomer, 'can do' attitude, kind, thoughtful, considerate, stickability

Art and Design

Explore how 2D drawings can be transformed to 3D objects. Work towards a sculptural outcome.

VOCAB: 2D drawing, 3D object, negative space, grid method, scaling up, collage, structure. balance



Design & Technology

Make a phone sock by using stitches to join textiles together.

VOCAB: Knot, back stitch, running stitch, cross stitch, whip stitch, button, applique, felt, needle, thread



Music

Developing melodic Phrases. Enquire into how music brings people together. Explore how music relates to friendship, peace, kindness, responsibility, charity, diplomacy

VOCAB: pop music, genre, loud, soft, guitar, bass, rhythm, timbre, pitch, temp, structure, texture, riff, main
